

TO: Mississippi Vehicle Owners
DATE: July 1, 2005
RE: Change in issuance of personalized (vanity) tag

Beginning July 1, 2005, motor vehicle owners that purchase a personalized or vanity tag will receive that plate by mail directly from the manufacturer. The tag should arrive *within 5-7 days* from the date purchased.

The tag will be mailed to the address provided to the Tax Collector at the time of purchase; therefore, it is very important that the mailing information is correct. If the tag is returned by the post office, cost of delivery by other means will be charged to the taxpayer. Car tags will not be forwarded by the Post Office. If you have not received the tag after (10) days call your county tax collector.

A regular tag will not be issued for this short period of time. The vehicle owner will be provided a tag receipt and two decals at the time the vanity tag is purchased. These documents should be maintained inside the registered vehicle and available for inspection by law enforcement.

When the tag is received from the manufacturer, the two decals should be placed on the tag as shown below:
